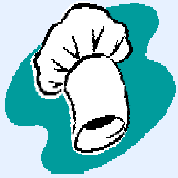
Fruity Flick Fridays - June 1,^{***} 7:00pm, 103-1033 Davie

Rainbow Connections endeavors to provide a framework for intergenerational one-to-one supportive relationships. The intention of Rainbow Connections is to match individuals of different generations with each other according to individual needs and interests. This will provide support to either younger or newer members of the LGTB communities, as well as to ageing/older and disabled members of the LGTB communities. It will help “bridge the generation gap” within the LGTB communities and contribute to building healthy relationships and communities. Rainbow Connections is directed at:

- LGTB Youth aged 16-25, who would like an LGTB adult mentor
- LGTB Adult aged 26+, who would like to mentor an LGTB Youth.
- Ageing/older or disabled members of the LGTB community who would like to be connected with a Resource Volunteer as a way to connect with the LGTB community through phone calls, visits, trips, etc...
- LGTB Youth or Adult who would like to spend time with an ageing/older or disabled person, providing various support and resources.
